Depart Dak Lak for Ho Chi Minh by air

Dak Lak province is an important land-locked province of Vietnam in the central highland. The province is rich in coffee, pepper, cocoa, cashew, fruit trees, and rubber and fruit trees. In 2023, the province exported USD 1.97 billion and imported USD 370 million.

Some of the major sectors for investment are renewable energy, high-tech agriculture, trade and services, and tourism: 05 Solar power projects of Xuan Thien Group, with a total capacity of 600 MW, total investment capital of 700 million USD; Ea Nam Wind Power Plant Project, with a total capacity of 400 MW, total investment capital of 630 million USD; DHN Dak Lak high-tech livestock area, investment capital of 22 million USD.
